The Master of Science in Vocational Education and Training prepares students to get into key positions in private or public sectors in VET. They will be the experts to further develop and evaluate the VET system in a national and international context.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

This Master of Science is aimed at people who intend to get a position in ...

... public services, companies, institutions or organizations - places where VET is developed, shaped, controlled, steered, managed and implemented.

... research institutions or universities – places where research and evaluation on VET is located and future trends are set.

THE MASTERS PROGRAM

- VET System

Students become familiar with both the Swiss and the international VET systems. They are the experts to monitor changes and add substantially to the further development of these systems.

- VET Interdisciplinarity

Students develop their knowledge, critical analysis and skills in fields like educational science, psychology, sociology, or economics.

- VET Research: methods and processes

Students are provided in opportunities to reflect and transform results from research into practical solutions in the field of VET. They are trained to develop methodological skills and run projects on their own.

- Topical questions in VET

Students focus on relevant issues related to the continuing development of the VET system. Favoring interactions with experts from different fields, with practitioners, researchers, or politicians, they define and establish the skills of the individuals in the context of training and continuing education. Students become familiar with the evolution of the VET system, the evolution of its individuals as well as its structures and with questions regarding the funding of the educational system.

- Practical training

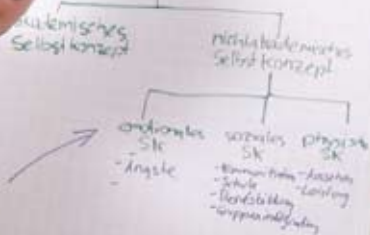
Within the Masters program students have to get involved in ongoing projects, a way to explore and evaluate projects and field work in real-life settings.

- Masters thesis and colloquium

The Master thesis is an empirical paper where students provide evidence that they are able to integrate interdisciplinary perspectives applied to a specific research question in VET.
